**TAX LEVY RESOLUTION
RESOLUTION NO. 819**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONDON GROVE, COUNTY OF CHESTER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FIXING THE TAX RATE AND CHATHAM LIGHT ASSESSMENT FOR THE YEAR 2024.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby resolved and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of London Grove, County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within the Township subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2024, as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 1.25 mills
 On each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of00125 cents
 On each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

For Chatham Lighting District, the sum of30 cents
 On each lineal foot of property frontage.

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

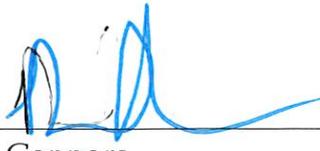

That any resolution of part of resolution, conflicting with this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this resolution.

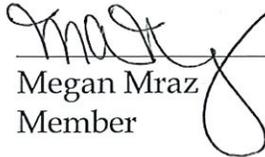

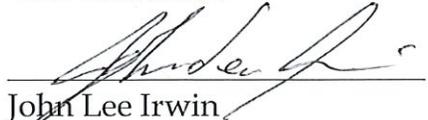
